Wenceslas Winter Fuel Project



Fleet Lions are looking to extend the highly successful Wenceslas Project (as run by Lions in Farnham and elsewhere in the Country) to Fleet and surrounding areas.

People in receipt of the Government winter fuel payment who do not feel in need of the payment (and others) are invited to help alleviate fuel debt and poverty by making an appropriate donation to a fund being set up to help those in need locally.

We know of many local people who have difficulty in keeping warm in winter. By working with agencies like the Citizens Advice Bureau we will ensure all donations go directly to help the fuel needy. We will ensure that all payments are made direct to the fuel utility companies on behalf of the families.

All administration costs associated with the scheme will be funded by the Lions.

Fleet Lions and Fleet Rotary's Christmas Floats tour different parts of Fleet and Church Crookham each year during December. The Fleet Lions Christmas Float is a joint venture with Hart Lions and usually raises over £7,000 for the community. The Lions start touring at 6.00pm and finish at 8.00pm as well as having static days at various locations in Fleet.

Fleet Lions 11th Hour Beerfest

We had 900 people at our 11th Hour Beerfest in August and they put away 450 gallons of beer and cider between them. They also raised just under £10,000 for Lions funds. Extra income of £900 was raised this year by Barclays match-funding our raffle.

£3,000 of the funds was committed to be donated to our region's centennial target of sponsoring a Hearing Dog.

Hearing Dogs for Deaf People train clever dogs to help deaf people by alerting them to sounds they would otherwise miss. They bring them independence, confidence and companionship. They train dogs to hear simple sounds that many people take for granted like the doorbell, alarm clock and even danger signals like the fire alarm. Being aware of these – thanks to a hearing dog – makes a real difference to deaf people's lives.

Fleet and Church Crookham Men's Shed

As well as making use of our own craft skills in the cause of Lions projects, Fleet Lions are also supporting the development of the Fleet and Church Crookham Men's Shed, a place where men can come together and share the tools and resources they need to work on projects at their own pace and in a safe, friendly environment. This community based network offers men who are retired or out of work, somewhere to meet, have a coffee and use existing or learn new skills, often for the benefit of the wider community.

Lions responding to disasters

Fleet Lions, and Lions Clubs worldwide, regularly donate to the Lions Club International Foundation. Just this year, these donations have enabled Lions to respond promptly to disasters from Japan to South Asia to the U.S. Gulf Coast, Mexico and the Caribbean. Last month, hurricane Harvey devastated the south central coast of Texas and areas of Louisiana. More recently, hurricane Irma struck Florida and laid waste to islands in the western Atlantic and Caribbean Sea.



Mexico has been rattled by its strongest earthquake in 100 years. Nepal and Bangladesh have also experienced monsoon rains not seen in many years with extensive flooding. Lions are supporting relief efforts for all these disasters.



LCIF work directly with Lions in the affected areas to ensure they have what they need to respond in these emergencies, and disaster relief funds have been made available in all the affected areas. In turn Lions are coordinating their efforts with local agencies to determine the greatest need and how Lions can help.


Donations to Fleet Lions Charitable Trust
