Wenceslas Winter Fuel Project



Fleet Lions will be continuing the Club's highly successful Wenceslas Project to support families who find themselves in fuel debt this coming winter by inviting people in receipt of the Government winter fuel payment, and others, to make a donation to the fund set up by Lions to help those in need. The Lions work directly with agencies like the Citizens Advice Bureau to ensure all donations go directly to help the fuel needy. All payments are made directly to the fuel utility companies on behalf of the families in need.

Prostate Cancer Checks

Prostate cancer kills around 11,800 men in the UK each year and around 47,000 new cases are diagnosed annually. Although men over the age of 50 are entitled to have a free NHS test to measure the level of Prostate Specific Antigen in their blood many do not ask and, at the moment, there is no national screening programme. However, from time to time, Fleet Lions offer free tests to men over 45vrs who have not had a PSA test before. This years' testing session was held at Fleet Hospital on the 19th September. Those tested will be individually notified of their results.

Free PCs and Laptops

Fleet Lions have teamed up with other Lions Clubs in the area and as part of the Microsoft Registered Refurbisher scheme are now refurbishing PCs and laptops and donating them with preinstalled Microsoft software to local non-profit organisations, charities, preschools and families in need.
